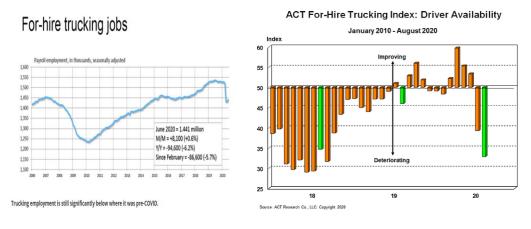




What is happening in the World?

Extremely Active Hurricane Season:

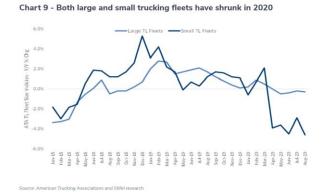
- 10 named storms in Sept alone
- First time since 1971 5 named storms in Atlantic basin at same time



Trucking Fleets continue to decrease – due to insurance, lack of drivers, cost of business, etc



 Truck Driver Shortage: "It is estimated that in 2020 the US will produce 40% fewer new truckers than normal"



...Not to mention tension with China, unemployment remains high, and COVID is still around

How is the Freight Market Responding?

Freight Demand – All time high:



...But Carriers are not taking loads....

How is the Freight Market Responding?

Cost Per Shipment continues to remain high - Constraints on Drivers, trucks, industry supply

Limited supply of trucks – causing shippers to pay more -Rates continue to rise

What drove this in the Supply Chain?

- Most Freight -> Related to Society's basic needs
 - Food, Shelter, Clothing, Transportation
- As COVID hit -> Started a RUN on most basic items
 - Can anyone remember the days of no toilet paper at the store?

Freight Demand spiked -> Carriers took highest paying loads -> Shippers started paying for Emergency shipments -> Carriers waited until perfect load

- Once Demand Leveled off -> Carriers Rates decreased -> Cooling of Market (...But the Freight was still there)
 - Warehouses were full of inventory -> Didn't want to get caught sleeping again
 - Imports of product started to increase
 - Carriers saw another opportunity to find the perfect load -> Start rejecting freight
- If you are a SHIPPER How do you feel?
- If you are a CARRIER How do you feel?

Two Main types of Brokerages:

- Traditional focuses on relationships
- Digital –focuses on technology

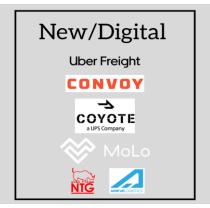
Pros of Digital:

- Saves Time Matches immediately
- Reduced paperwork all handled through App
- Optimized routes
- Lower Prices Prices lowered to compete in market
- Increases Efficiency Automation of booking, matching and admin

Cons of Digital:

- No single point of contact
- Due to be dependent on technology, lacks human touch when issues arise
- Service is component of correctly matching carrier
- Many digital brokers can not meet specialized needs only focus is dry van, flatbed, availability of drivers
- Works great until it doesn't





Cons of Traditional:

- Time Consuming Operations: Manual operations translates to more time shippers spend waiting to know if load will be covered
- High Prices: Averaged brokerage fee ranges from 15%-20% - translates to high costs for shippers
- · Limited Pool of Carriers: Ability to supply the right truck to the right place at the right time is limited by number of trucks
- Lack of Visibility of shipments: Shippers lose visibility to On Time Pickup and On Time Delivery and need access to tech that traditional brokerages do not have
- Less Reliable for Contract Freight: When the market tightens and prices go up, brokers often reject freight they agreed to take
