Texas Logistics Education Foundation Scholarships in an amount up to \$1000 per semester for a maximum of four semesters are competitively awarded by an industry Scholarship Committee on the basis of academic excellence, merit, and professionalism. Your **typed** application must include the following items to be considered:

1. Complete the scholarship application on the reverse side of this page. **Return the application with the items requested in 2-5 below to the Center for Logistics Education and Research, Room 228 of the Business Administration Building or mail to the address below.**
2. A complete set of transcripts showing all academic work to date, including transfer work.
3. A one-page letter of application including, but not limited to, career goals and how you are preparing for your chosen career - must be typed!
4. A complete typed resume including work experience, activities, and educational background.
5. Names and contact information for three references. Do not submit letters with the initial application.

Scholarship winners should understand that:

1. Payment authorization will be made only after course enrollment and eligibility requirements are verified by the Center on the 12th class day of the semester. Scholarship winners are strongly encouraged to register early.
2. Your actual course enrollment will be verified during the semesters you receive a scholarship. If you do not meet the eligibility requirements listed on the back page throughout the semester, the scholarship will be revoked.

Scholarship students from out-of-state MAY be eligible for reduction of tuition to in-state levels; however, it is not automatic. You must request it. Students who request the reduction are strongly encouraged to go through early registration. If you wait to register at the regular time, you may NOT have the opportunity to receive a tuition waiver.

Award:

The scholarships will range from \$500 to \$1,000 per semester up to a maximum of \$4000.

Eligibility:

1. Currently enrolled Sophomore, Junior, or Senior with a minimum overall GPA of 2.75;
2. Scholarships awards are competitively awarded to Texas residents and non-residents on the basis of academic excellence, merit and professional qualifications. **You must be a declared logistics major.** You, the student, must maintain a 3.00 GPA for all courses taken following award of the scholarship;
3. Scholarship funding is awarded only for classes in the logistics degree plan at the 3000-4000 level;
4. Both full-time and part-time students may apply, but must be enrolled for a minimum of 6 hours.
5. Be at least one semester away from graduation. This means that an undergraduate student must have at least 15 uncompleted hours at the time the scholarship is awarded;
6. The applications meeting the minimum criteria will be forwarded to the scholarship committee of the Texas Logistics Education Foundation for final selection
7. Selected students are required to attend the Scholarship Recognition Awards program of the academic unit held in April each year. Students agree to complete alumni surveys to track career progress.

Every scholarship recipient must sign the University of North Texas **Grade and Enrollment Information Release Form** and **Scholarship Acceptance Agreement**. These documents will be furnished to you if you are selected as a scholarship recipient.
